1	Punta Arenas, Chile 蓬塔阿雷納斯/智利	<p>Start of the Air-Cruise 海空聯航開始</p> <p>Arrive in Punta Arenas, Chile, before 2 PM, where you are welcomed by Antarctica21 staff and transferred to your hotel. In the afternoon, you are welcomed at Explorers House to attend a mandatory briefing that provides important information about your air-cruise and reviews the essential guidelines for Antarctic visitors. Later, gather for a welcome dinner and meet your fellow adventurers while enjoying a typical regional menu.</p> <p>請於下午2點之前抵達智利蓬塔阿雷納斯機場，南極21世紀的工作人員將在機場接機，並送您到酒店入住。下午前往探索者之家大本營，參加行前強制性安全說明會，包括飛南極行程重要信息及南極遊覽指南等。隨後享用歡迎晚宴，與一起參加探險之旅的朋友們見面，品嚐地方特色美食。</p>
2	Flight to King George Island 英皇佐治島	<p>Scheduled flight to Antarctica 飛往南極</p> <p>George Island, in the South Shetland Islands. As you exit the airplane, the clear Antarctic air fills your lungs for the first time. Each day disembark by Zodiac and explore the landscape together with expert polar guides. On board the ship, attend an engaging program of educational presentations, and enjoy spectacular views from the lounge while sharing your daily adventures with fellow guests.</p> <p>No journey is the same and flexibility is the key to success in Antarctica. The Expedition Team plans the voyage route to take advantage of the ever-changing opportunities provided by nature, crafting a unique and extraordinary experience every time. While the exact itinerary changes with each expedition, you will explore several sites that offer the best possible overview of the varied Antarctic environment. Your voyage may include visits to sites in the South Shetland Islands, the Antarctic Sound, the Gerlache Strait, and the Penola Strait.</p>

- Fares quoted are per person in US\$ Dollars based on double occupancy . Single/Triples is available on request basic & subject to availability.
- Non-refundable deposit US\$4000per person is required when make reservation . No changes is allowed once payment is made.
- The Balance shall be paid no later than 150days prior to the departure date and full payment is non-refundable after due date.
- Fares listed on the flyer are based on the printed date and it is subject to availability and to be confirmed at the time of a paid reservation.
- Passenger full name as shown on travel document is required at the time of booking .
- Passenger passport validity is required to have a least 6 months prior the return date and valid traveling visas is granted . Travel Agency & Cruise company will not be liable for any consequences.
- Passport copy & participants from are required when make reservation.
- Antarctica XXI requires participants to be adequately covered by a travel insurance policy that covers aero-medical evacuation form Antarctica as a result of a medical emergency during the trips , included emergencies related to pre-existing health conditions.
- Participants are required to fill out and submit online Participation Form and return it to Antarctica21 at least 120 days prior to departure. Based on the medical information provided in the form, Antarctica21's Medical Director may request a medical certificate. All participants 75 years of age and older must submit a medical certificate.
- Every effort will be made to adhere to the planned program. However, with this type of adventurous travel to Antarctica, changes to the itinerary may occur due to severe and changeable weather. We need to emphasize the fact that weather conditions are unpredictable, and safety is always the paramount concern on any Antarctic voyage. For this reason, Antarctica21 reserves the right to change the itinerary described due to weather conditions or other factors beyond Antarctica21's control without consulting the participants.
- Antarctica XXI strongly urges participants to be adequately covered by trip cancellation and interruption insurance.
- Antarctica XXI air-cruise expeditions are suitable for adventurous travelers who enjoy full mobility and reasonable good health . Expedition travel to Antarctica requires flexibility and adaptation to ever-changing circumstances.
- The maximum weight allowed on the flights luggage to and from Antarctica is 20KG (44lb.) per passenger, including hand luggage.
- The official expedition language of our Air-Cruises is English. The voyage will take travelers to remote destinations where the interaction with our polar guides is essential.
- Flights to and from Antarctica operate based on weather conditions. While historically only a minority of flight have experienced a delay , you should be prepare for that possibility.
- Antarctica XXI also reserves the right (in its sole and absolute discretion) to alter or omit any part of the itinerary with due notice to the passengers wherever practicable. Such rescheduling does not constitute a cancellation by Antarctica21. All reasonable efforts will be made by Antarctica XXI to ensure that the passenger's travel objectives are met.
- Antarctica21 has the duty to advise passengers that all expeditions are subject to constantly changing weather conditions in the visited regions and that the safety and comfort of passengers and crew will never be put at risk by taking actions that may result in a disappointing end to a unique experience.
